Does your room phone meet ADA (Americans with Dis- abilities Act) standards?

"Essential" telephones such as hotel/motel in-room telephones are required to have a single step volume boost of 12 – 15db (decibels). There are phones being sold in our industry that do NOT meet, nor come close to, this Federal regulation. Be sure to ask to see the manufacturer's ADA Certificates, they should have them for all models. It only takes one hearing-impaired person, who is in need, for there to be a tragedy or a lawsuit.
